I have now had an opportunity to review your letter of 2 July 1992, with Burlington Northern operating officers.

The trackage in question is what is known as CTC (Centralized Traffic Control) siding. It is normally not to be used for switching or storage purposes. I am told it will not be so used in the future. This does not mean that emergent circumstances might not occur which would require the use of the track for more than simple passing purposes; however, such use would be transient and very infrequent.
