full moon walks, art, dance, Culmination Weekend to among family and friends.



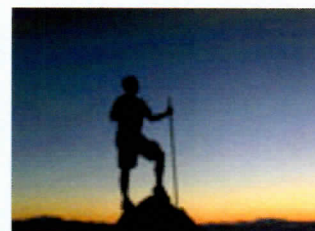
## APOLLO'S CROSSING

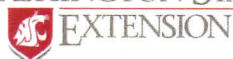
We welcome young people from all schools, public/private or homeschooled. Accepting just eight in each program, we create a supportive and intimate environment, to honor each young person and their family.
